ADVISORY NOTICE

In the event that the interior was damaged by water or crawl space and or basement was flooded and the wiring, receptacles, switches or panels were comprised, it is recommended that a New Jersey licensed electrical contractor be contacted to inspect, evaluate and make necessary repairs or replacements.

Similarly, in the event that the water heater or heating cooling equipment was submerged, it is recommended that a New Jersey licensed plumber or mechanical contractor inspect, evaluate and make the necessary repairs or replacements. All work shall be inspected by the local code enforcement agency before final payment is made to the contractor.

All electrical appliances, equipment and circuits damaged by flood water shall be disconnected until it is replaced.

The following must be filled out and signed by the owner of the property and this form mailed along with a Construction Permit Application and Electrical Subcode Technical to Stafford Township, Department of Building Inspections.
